Seasonal / Monthly Policies

Seasonal camping will consist of: 27 weekends (2 nights per week), three holidays (Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day) and four weeks vacation (5 nights per week). Vacation time may be used at your discretion. Substitutions of unused weekends for vacation time are not permitted. Families exceeding this time limit will be charged \$75.00 per family per week.

Seasonal rates are based on a family of two adults and two children. Children are described as unmarried, dependent and under 21 years of age. An additional child family member, 3 years or older, is required to pay \$30 per season. An additional adult family member is required to pay \$45.00 per season.

All visitors must stop and register at the office and receive a visitor pass. The charge is \$3.00 per day (8 am – 11 pm) for anyone 3 years or older. If visitors plan to stay in your camper while you are not in attendance, the office should be notified prior to their arrival. Visitor fee may be prepaid, but your visitors still must stop and register in the office.

A water check valve is required on the outside faucet by order of the Health Department (check valves are available at the office).

Sewer connections of plastic PVC tubing are preferred. If you use expandable hose, it must be suspended off the ground.

When an additional outside electrical source is needed, please use heavy duty extension cords. Do not bury any electrical cords. Romex is not permitted.

Please keep your campsite tidy and your trailer clean. The outside of each trailer must be cleaned (scrubbed) once per season. Trailers may be washed late Sunday afternoon or during the week only. No washing of cars or trucks permitted at any time.

Campsite grass must be cut or mowed (during the growing season) once every 2 weeks. Failure to do so will result in the lawn being mowed by the management at a \$20.00 charge per cutting. There is a campground lawn mower for your use.

Each camp site is limited to one boat dock rental space, if available. All other boats will be stored in the parking area at the lakefront. Boat fees are due by May 15th. All boats and boat pools must be removed from the water in the Fall, prior to the removal of the docks (date will be announced).

All trailers left in winter storage must have a current license tag, or be removed from the park for the winter. Any resulting taxation to the management for non-compliance must be reimbursed by the trailer owner.

For Sale signs may not be displayed on any camper, trailer, boat or equipment. Contact the office for the procedure to follow prior to advertise any items for sale.

Electric bills will be available for pick-up at the office by the 20th of each month. It is your responsibility to pick up and pay this monthly bill within a two week period.

Any changes to your campsite must be approved by the management, prior to you making the changes. Permanent improvements will remain the property of the campground upon your departure.

Management must approve the year and condition of all seasonal trailers.

Seasonal campers are welcome to use their trailers before and after the regular season at a camping fee of \$15.00 per night.

One shed is permitted per seasonal campsite. Sheds are not to exceed 8' x 6' with a 7' high peak.

Seasonal/monthly campers are required to provide proof of insurance on their unit. Golf cart owners must provide a certificate of insurance showing liability coverage on their golf cart. Please submit a copy of your insurance cards to the office at the beginning of each season.

Golf cart operators must be licensed drivers, obey the speed limit, one-way signs and all rules of the road.

No burning of leaves pre- or post-season, unless the water is on and your hose is connected and ready for flare-ups.

Cash or checks are preferred for seasonal charges. There will be a \$25.00 per month late fee for all delinquent seasonal charges.
